

Proclamation Concerning Coronavirus Pandemic

The City of Savannah, The Village of Country Club and

The Andrew County Health Department

September 21, 2020

The Andrew County Commission, the Savannah City Council, the Country Club Village Council and the Andrew County Health Department, in recognition of an increased resurgence of the Coronavirus infection rate within the County and various municipalities within the County, adopt and support the following proclamation.

Due to the recent increase in the testing affirmed infection rate within Andrew County and surrounding Counties, the above mentioned authorities encourage citizens to familiarize themselves with and make a determined effort to adhere to the recommended procedures for addressing the pandemic developed by the Andrew County Health Department under guidance from the Center for Disease Control (CDC).

- Wear a mask when in public.
- Follow local public health department guidance on isolation/quarantine requirements.
- If you feel sick, stay home. Do not go to work. Contact your medical provider.
- If your children are sick, keep them at home. Do not send them to school. Contact your medical provider.
- If someone in your household has tested positive for coronavirus, keep the entire household at home.
- If you are an older person, stay home and away from other people.
- If you are a person with a serious underlying health condition that can put you at increased risk, stay home and away from other people.
- Avoid social gatherings in groups of more than 10 people.
- If dining out, adhere to social distancing recommendations and practice good hygiene. Consider drive-thru, pickup or delivery alternatives.
- Practice good hygiene:
  - Wash your hands, especially after touching any frequently used item or surface.
  - Avoid touching your face.
  - Sneeze or cough into a tissue, or the inside of your elbow.
  - Disinfect frequently used items and surfaces as much as possible.


We thank the citizenry for their cooperation and diligence in addressing these issues. We are confident that if everyone embraces these recommendations, we can decrease the infection rate within our communities.
